**The Two-Day Training Seminar for Primary Education Teachers in Kozani was
completed with great success**

Topic: “Integrating Education for Disaster Risk Reduction from Natural Hazards into the Primary Education Curriculum”

The two-day training seminar for Primary Education teachers, organized by the Directorate of Primary Education of Kozani in collaboration with the Competence Center for a Sustainable and Resilient Built Environment (SURE), the Cyprus Pedagogical Institute and the Cyprus Mathematical Society, was held with great success and impressive participation.

The seminar took place on **Tuesday 21 and Wednesday 22 October 2025**, in the Multipurpose Hall of the 19th Primary School of Kozani (ZEP), within the framework of the European Erasmus+ KA2 “Guidelines for Developing and Implementing Disaster Risk Reduction Education in Elementary School Curriculum”, implemented from 1 September 2024 to 31 August 2026.

The participation of more than 80 teachers from school units of the Regional Unit of Kozani highlighted the strong desire of the educational community to incorporate teaching on the prevention and management of natural disasters into school practices. Participants had the opportunity to actively engage in experiential activities, natural hazard simulations and interdisciplinary approaches that strengthen understanding and preparedness for risks related to climate change.

The speakers presented innovative educational tools, sample teaching scenarios and examples of integrating Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) Education into various subject areas, offering teachers substantial support for the practical application of the principles of sustainable development in the classroom.
