Two-Day Training Seminar for Primary Education Teachers in Kozani

Subject: “Integrating Disaster Risk Reduction Education for Natural Hazards into the Primary Education Curriculum”

The **Directorate of Primary Education of Kozani**, in cooperation with the **Competence Centre for a Sustainable and Resilient Built Environment through Smart Technologies (SURE)**, the **Cyprus Pedagogical Institute** and the **Cyprus Mathematical Society**, is organising a **two-day training seminar for primary education teachers** on the following topic:

“Integrating Disaster Risk Reduction Education for Natural Hazards into the Primary Education Curriculum”,

within the framework of the **European Erasmus+ Programme “Guidelines for Developing and Implementing Disaster Risk Reduction Education in Elementary School Curriculum”**.

The two-day seminar will take place on **Tuesday, 21 October** and **Wednesday, 22 October 2025**, from **16:30 to 20:00**, in the **Multipurpose Hall of the 19th Primary School of Kozani (ZEP)**.

The training programme aims to strengthen teachers’ knowledge and skills concerning risk reduction in relation to natural hazards and climate change through interdisciplinary approaches, educational activities, and links to the curriculum.

During the training, the following will be presented:

- Indicative teaching scenarios and activities simulating natural phenomena.
- Real-world data and tools that can be used in the learning process.
- Examples of integrating Disaster Risk Reduction Education (DRR) into different curriculum subjects.

This activity forms part of the European Project STEAME-DRREC (Disaster Risk Reduction and Climate Change Education), implemented under Erasmus+ KA2 from 1 September 2024 to 31 August 2026, with the participation of organisations from Greece and Cyprus.
